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Summer 2020 In-Person Programing Terms and Conditions

Overview

The John F. Green Spartanburg Science Center (hereinafter: "The Center") is implementing the following policy based on CDC guidelines from May 19, 2020. Families are required to read and agree to abide by the following practices in order to enroll [a] participant[s] in The Center's 2020 in-person programing.

- **Parents and guardians are not permitted to enter The Center, including using The Center restrooms.**
- **Participants must be picked-up in between morning and afternoon camps for disinfecting in between camp groups.**

Sick Campers and Participant Qualifications

Families that have returned from travel within two weeks of an in-person camp are encouraged to notify The Center and sign up for a later camp.

- **Sick campers will be removed from camp and their guardian called for pick-up.**
- **The Science Center is not responsible for the potential exposure of and/or the subsequent illness of any participant or family member.**
- **Refunds or camp exchanges will be made at the discretion of The Center.**

Pick-up and Drop-Off

Families will drop off students in the designated area within the Chapman Cultural Center parking lot nearest Barnet Park.

- **Drop-off and pick up times are as follows:**
 - **Morning camp: Drop-off 9:45am, Pick-up 11:55am**
 - **Afternoon camp: Drop-off 12:55pm, Pick-up 2:55pm**
- **Drop-off vehicles will park in spaces closest to the Science Center side door.**
- **Guardians are expected to remain in vehicles, or socially distanced (6ft apart) outside.**
- **Instructors will bring the camper sign-in and sign-out clipboard to families' cars.**
- **Science Center campers will enter and exit The Center through the "Back Entrance" door facing the drop-off area accompanied by Science Center Instructors.**

Camper Behavior

- **Campers are encouraged to bring and wear their own face mask.**
- **Campers are not permitted to bring toys or materials from home, including food.**
- **Campers will be spaced 6ft apart and given their own kit/materials to work with for the duration of the camp. Siblings are permitted to share a table.**
- **Upon entering the classroom, campers will take turns washing their hands.**
- **Campers will not be permitted into The Center's Exhibit Hall or Animal Room.**
 - **Campers will receive a pass to visit The Center for later use.**
